Target Audience

Commissioned law enforcement officers and instructors seeking an in-depth knowledge of the Texas Transportation Code and associated rules and manuals.

Course Description

This course covers areas of the Transportation Code that frequently create confusion, uncertainty, or complexity for peace officers. Areas of study include:

- Understanding Reasonable Suspicion, Probable Cause, and Culpable Mental States
- Application of Administrative Code and Case Law
- Important Definitions and TRC Applicability
- Vehicle Registration and License Plates
- Driver's Licenses and Commercial Driver's Licenses
- Compliance with Traffic Control Devices
- Moving Violations
- Emergency Vehicle Operation
- Vehicle Lighting and the Federal 108 Lighting Standard
- Bicycles, Golf Carts, and Off-Highway Vehicles
- Pedestrians
- Provisions Regarding Vehicle Size and Weight

Law enforcement officers will be introduced to supporting resources such as Texas Administrative Rule, the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 49 C.F.R. 571.108 Federal Lighting Standard, case law, and TXDPS guidance documents. Students will gain confidence in their enforcement decisions and will develop tools to employ in a well-rounded traffic enforcement and crash investigation program.

This is a free course available to law enforcement officers.

This course will be instructed by TXDPS Transportation Code instructors with years of TRC training experience.
